Scholarship Guidelines

- Must be a resident of Huntington County, Indiana
- Only high school seniors are eligible to apply
- Will be expected to complete the school year for which the scholarship is awarded
- Scholastic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community service/leadership skills, financial need, and references will be used as criteria for evaluating the applications
- These supporting materials must be included with the application:
 - A grade transcript from the high school
 - Letters of recommendation from at least two high school teachers who had you in class, and will attest to your character, initiative and studious behavior. Additional letters of recommendation from adults outside of the school system, and not a relative, are welcome
 - A parent confidential statement
 - An essay of no more than 300 words which relates your past accomplishments, future plans, and financial need. Explain how your degree meets the requirement for the scholarship you are applying to receive; The Chuck Wohlford Scholarship pertains to Education and the Huntington Metro Kiwanis Scholarship pertains to Human Services.
- Applicants are asked to identify the scholarship for which they are applying.
- The deadline for submitting your completed application and **supporting materials** is **April 5, 2019**.
